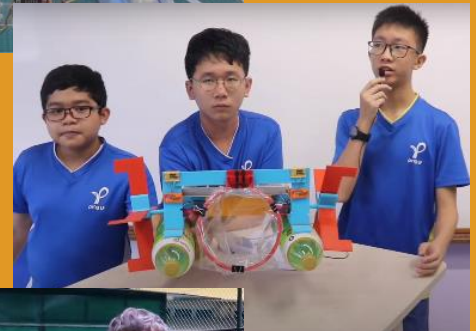
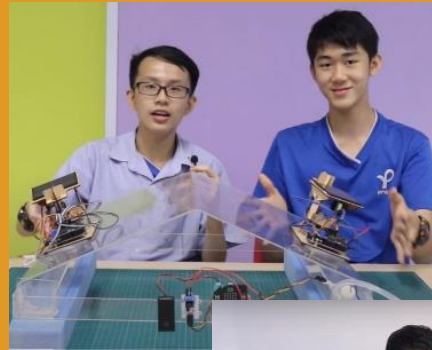


## IDE (Innovation, Design and Engineering) Series 2020 Awards:

## Safe Management Measures Phase 3 2021

In Phase 3, face-to-face activities have been reintroduced with Safe Management Measures for Co-curricular activities.

1. **Safe distancing:** Students must be at least one metre apart. When taking part in physical activities, they must be at least two metres apart.
2. **Grouping:** Students must be in groups of maximum 8 students. There must be a distance of 1 metre between groups. If they are taking part in physical activities, they must be 3 metres apart.
3. **Gatherings:** The maximum number of students, staff and instructors carrying out low-risk activities at a single venue with safe distancing measures in place is 50.
4. **Temperature Taking:** Teachers check students' well-being and temperature before, during and after the activity.

### Contact Tracing

1. Students sit according to a grouping plan and/or the seating plan.
2. Teachers take the attendance of students present everyday.
3. Instructors complete an online declaration before entering the school.
4. Teachers regularly check if students and instructors have been in contact with any confirmed COVID-19 cases. They will inform the school immediately if any cases are found.
